In July 2021, the Government established the National Energy Authority (NEA) to be the regulator of the electricity supply sector in Papua New Guinea. Since 2013, PNG Power has absorbed all cost increases from fuel and other CPI

components whilst keeping the same retail tariff for electricity.

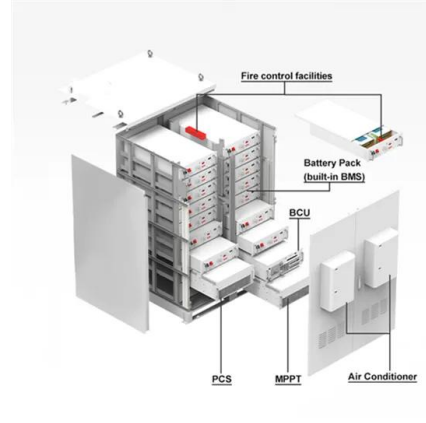

Do you need a voltage converter in Papua New Guinea? Yes, you'll likely need a voltage converter. In Papua New Guinea the standard voltage is 240V with a frequency of 50Hz. This doesn't match the 120V standard in the United States. Therefore, not every device will work with just a travel adapter.
