Housing options for college students fall into one of three camps: You can live in a dorm, rent your own apartment, or (if your college offers this option) join a fraternity or sorority.

Transfer students are eligible to live on campus and nearby in the off-campus student housing properties.

Can a student live in a dorm?

When students live in dorms or other housing on campus, they still have protection from laws in their state and federally. These laws make sure that there are no unlawful intrusions into their private life. For example, the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) prohibits schools from sharing a student's records without permission.

Should a first-year student live in a dorm?

Best for: Patel recommends dorms for first-year students looking for a social atmosphere and a true taste of campus life. Many colleges require first-year students to live in dorm housing; after that first year, however, many consider moving off campus and other options (more on that next). ——— Should you rent an apartment off campus?

Can a student live in a residence hall?

In the second year of residency, students may live in university residence halls, and are permitted to live in approved, university-affiliated housing, which may include on- and off-campus housing owned or controlled by a registered or recognized student organization and university-owned cooperative houses (co-ops).

Should freshmen live in a dorm?

Many schools require that freshmen live in dorms or at home with their parents, and dorm life provides students with a halfway point between their parents' home and independent living. However, the cramped quarters of a dormitory can feel stifling for some students, and renting a house can be a good option for students who can afford to do so.
