Solar panels can be installed without drilling into the roof using several methods, such as Ballasted mounting systems, solar shingles or tiles, thin-film solar panels or ground mounting standard panels.

A simple way to avoid roof leaks in the first place is to mount the structural supports directly on top of the felt paper. We then apply polyethylene caulking directly to the lag before we ratchet it into the structural member. 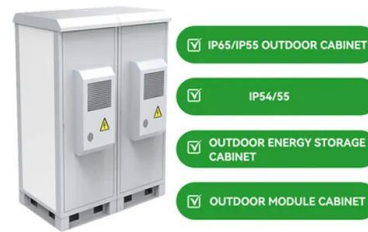
