Both the Captain and the First Officer share these roles - usually one of them is PF on the outbound leg and the other one is PM on the inbound leg. The PF manipulates the controls to actually fly the plane, whereas the PM handles communications and other required tasks that don't involve actually flying the plane.

Generally, co-pilots fly an aircraft when either the main pilot is on a break or there is an emergency. A co-pilot is essentially a backup pilot who's onboard to take command when the Pilot in Charge (PIC) can't. Co-pilots ensure a safe flight by assisting the PIC through the following 5 major duties. 1.

That means the captains no longer have sole responsibility. Since they no longer have sole responsibility, they also no longer have full authority either.

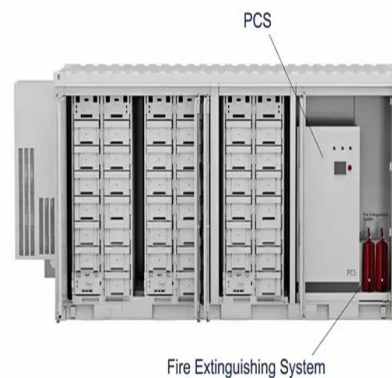

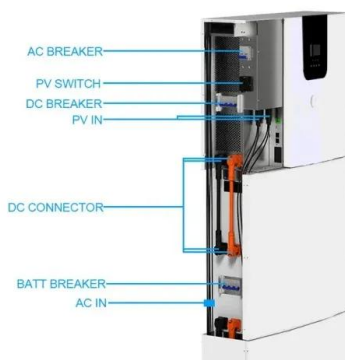
