The short and simple answer is NO, rain will NOT clean your solar panels. While rainwater may remove some dirt or dust particles from the surface, it's not enough to keep them clean and efficient.

In most areas of the country, occasional rain is typically enough to naturally and safely keep your solar panels clean and free of debris that could lower their energy production.

A good rain shower will rinse dust and debris off the panels to keep them working at around 95% capacity.

PV panels can naturally be cleaned by rain, but the cleaning effectiveness varies based on the amount of rain. Does rain clean solar panels?

Rain, in essence, is nature's way of washing and cleaning. It does a decent job in removing loose dust and light dirt from the solar panels. If your panels are installed at a steeper angle, the rainwater can more efficiently wash away the surface dust. However, the efficiency of rain as a cleaning agent is dependent on the nature of the dirt.

Never clean solar panels without your feet firmly planted on a stable surface. While cleaning, it's crucial to avoid damaging any electrical components, as this could make the solar panels less effective or disrupt their operation altogether. Always weigh the safety risks and benefits before cleaning your solar panels.

How do you protect solar panels from dew & rain?

One possible solution is a coating over the surface of solar panels. An example of this strategy is a hydrophobic coating, meaning it repels water. If the panel is at a steep enough angle, dew or rain would run down its surface and wash away the dust. But in installations where the angle of the panel is nearly horizontal that will not work.

Do solar panels need to be cleaned after a downpour?

Whether you have a rigid rooftop array or a series of portable solar panels, it's best to keep cleaning to a bare minimum. While rooftop panels should be fine after a downpour, call a cleaning service if in doubt. For your portable panels, keep it simple with water, and a soft cloth.

How are hybrid solar panels cleaned?

Hybrid solar panels are cleaned in the exact same way as a photovoltaic or thermal panel, meaning with soft, lukewarm water and a non-abrasive sponge. As far as of the photovoltaic side is concerned, this procedure is identical to that of a classic panel, which consists of verifying the cables, the production housing, and the solar inverter.

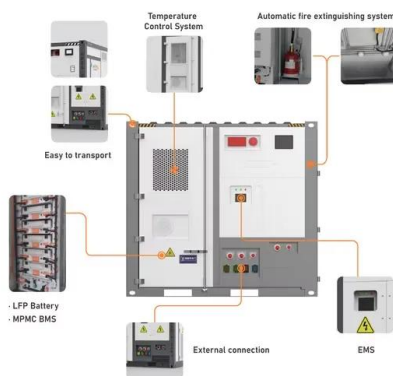

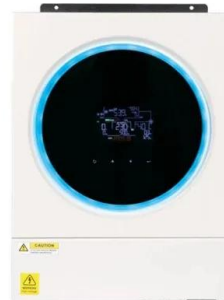
