The CAR is a member of the Economic and Monetary Community of Central Africa (CEMAC) and the Economic Community of Central African States (ECCAS). However, similar to other African regions, these economic communities remain insignificant when it comes to promoting intra-regional trade.

How does conflict management work in Central African Republic?

Conflict management happens mostly on the local level in communities, especially when their conditions are generally peaceful. Strong civil society actors and organizations have never existed in the Central African Republic.

How many political parties are there in Central African Republic?

According to the Ministry of Territorial Administration, in 2019, there were more than 90 political parties in the Central African Republic. The president's party, the United Hearts Movement, was only founded in 2018.

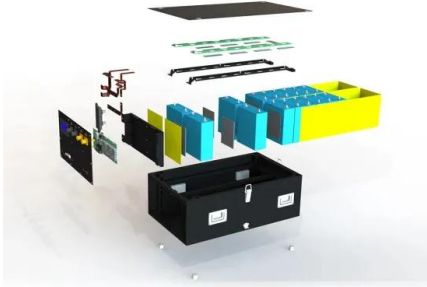

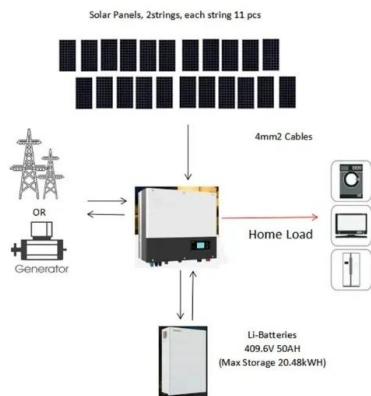

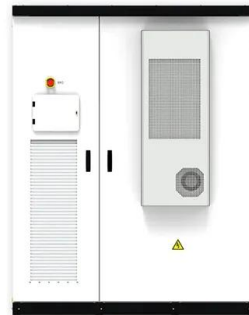
