However, PV panels may suffer from incompetent installation, degradation of anti-reflective coating, glass breakage, microcracks in interconnectors and other damages even before reaching their warranty lifetime, and those cannot be repaired will participate in PV waste stream ahead of the normal lifetime.

Some farmers worry that solar panels will leach heavy metals into the soil. (Supplied: FirstSolar) As the number of solar farms grows in Australia, so does the debate over heavy metals that solar panels might contain and the challenge of recycling used panels.

Are solar panels dangerous?

The International Energy Agency studied the risk to human health from heavy metals leaching out of solar panels and reported it was below US screening levels, while water contamination levels were within the guidelines from the World Health Organization.

Are solar panels a problem?

The vast quantity of waste from all of those sources is a concern and we need to find ways to reduce waste, but solar panels are not a major issue in that larger conversation. Solar panels do not contain harmful levels of the toxic materials that often get discussed at public hearings about development.

Are leachates toxic to solar cells?

First, the ecotoxicity of leachates from solar cell devices should be investigated. This review found very limited research on the ecotoxicity of leachate or its main ingredients, for older solar cells (crystalline silicon-based solar cells) as well as emerging solar cells (perovskite-based solar cells).

What's wrong with solar panel waste?

A Path Forward on Solar Panel Waste Perhaps the biggest problem with solar panel waste is that there is so much of it, and that's not going to change any time soon, for a basic physical reason: sunlight is dilute and diffuse and thus require large collectors to capture and convert the sun's rays into electricity.

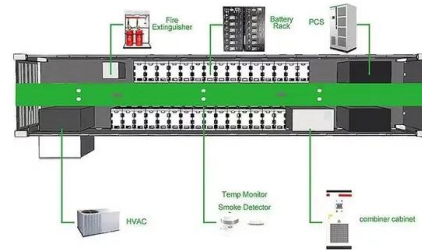
