According to the World Health Organization, there is no significant research that proves living near a solar farm is harmful due to EMF exposure. Do people who live near solar projects get notice?

This indicates that processes for giving notice to people who live near projects are not working. The most trusted sources of information are people who live near existing solar projects, community organizations and university staff. The least trusted are solar developers and government officials.

Is living near a solar farm harmful?

According to the World Health Organization, there is no significant research that proves living near a solar farm is harmful due to EMF exposure. Still, in general, solar farms are required to be built at least 3 km (1.86 miles) from residential areas. It's a good idea to know if the operation is a large scale farm or a small scale.

How many people live near solar projects?

A team that included researchers from Lawrence Berkeley, the University of Michigan and Michigan State University conducted the survey in 2023. The responses came from 984 people in 39 states who live near solar projects built between 2017 to 2021. The projects range in size from 1 megawatt to 252 megawatts. Among the other findings:.
