Belize Electric Company Limited (BECOL) was owned by Fortis Energy Cayman Inc. (FECI), which acquired 95% of its interest in January 2001. The remaining 5% was owned by the Social Security Board of Belize (SSB) until May 2004, when Fortis Energy Cayman Inc. purchased it. In September 2022, BECOL formally rebranded and became Fortis Belize Limited (FBL).

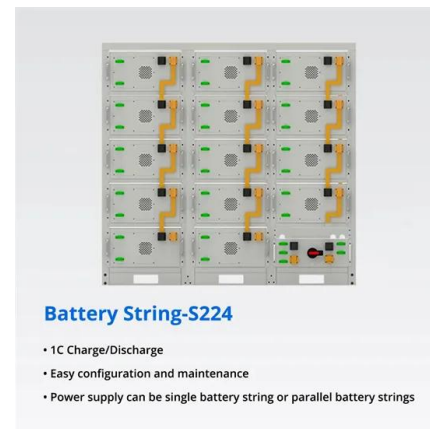

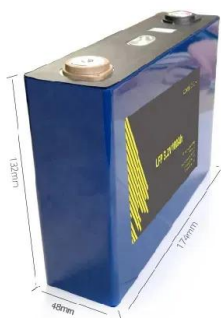
