Overview

What transformations are taking place in Equatorial Guinea in 2022?

No data for Equatorial Guinea for 2022. Another important form of transformation is the generation of electricity. Thermal power plants generate electricity by harnessing the heat of burning fuels or nuclear reactions – during which up to half of their energy content is lost.

Does Equatorial Guinea want a foreign company to take over Exxon?

The Exxon situation is a case in point. Equatorial Guinea wanted a foreign company to take over the assets from Exxon and has been wooing international oil companies including Eni, the Italian producer, and several Nigerian companies, according to a former senior US official familiar with the matter. None have shown any interest so far.

Why did Exxon cut its production in Equatorial Guinea?

Despite Exxon's history of doing business in Equatorial Guinea for almost three decades, the company decided to cut its losses altogether after a safety incident in 2022 decimated its output. That year, water leaked into a production vessel at the Zafiro field, Exxon's main asset in the country, forcing the platform to be retired two months later.

Is Equatorial Guinea a reversal of fortunes?

It almost marks a reversal of fortunes for Equatorial Guinea, which was once a hotbed of promise when Mobil discovered oil there and Exxon increased production after its takeover in 1999. But oil production has been steadily declining in recent years, down more than 80 per cent from the boom years.

Should Equatorial Guinea be doing everything it can?

Now, in a more competitive environment, where Equatorial Guinea is jockeying for dollars with Gabon, Cameroon, Namibia, Suriname, and Guyana, the government should be doing everything it can to finalize negotiations and

fast-track projects, not sitting back on its heels and waiting for — what?

How many soldiers are there in Equatorial Guinea?

The Armed Forces of Equatorial Guinea consists of approximately 2,500 service members. The army has almost 1,400 soldiers, the police 400 paramilitary men, the navy 200 service members, and the air force about 120 members. There is also a gendarmerie, but the number of members is unknown.

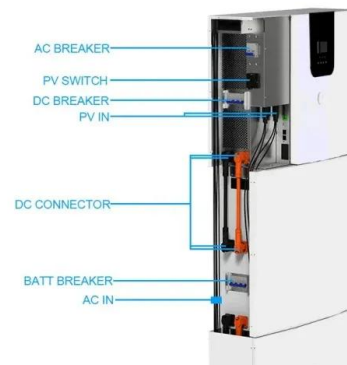

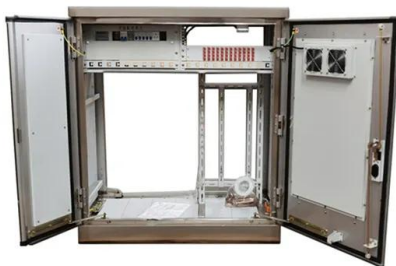
Equatorial Guinea is a small country located in Central Africa between Cameroon and Gabon. It

Sendje Hydroelectric Power Station is a 200 megawatts (270,000 hp) hydroelectric power station under construction in Equatorial Guinea. The power station is under development by the Government of Equatorial Guinea, with funds borrowed from the Development Bank of Central African States (BDEAC).
