# How hot should I use a hair dryer to blow my hair



## Overview

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And when it comes to safely using heat for a non-damaging blow dry, you need to begin with semi-dry hair, use negative ion technology, direct the airflow, and select the lowest heat temps possible .

The Best Ways to Blow-Dry Your Hair Without Damaging It1. Split Your Hair into Sections Blow-drying your hair in sections helps you control the direction of the heat and its angle on your locks. 2. Keep the Heat on Medium Medium heat is hot enough to smooth and style your locks without scorching them. 3. Dry from Root to Tip to Seal Cuticles . 4. Avoid Over-Drying .

Then, with your dryer on the coolest setting (don't touch that hot setting!), blow your hair dry, keeping the dryer about 6-inches away from hair at all times and moving it around continuously.

Below, Alvarez explains which heat setting each hair type should use and why:"Low heat is best for fine hair. This is also true for weaker hair that has been severely damaged." "Medium heat is best for fine to medium textures. "High heat may be used on really thick or coarse hair to remove excessive moisture and if your hair is really healthy, you can also use higher heat to help control frizz. .

And if you want to blow-dry your hair, remove excess water with a towel first, then use your dryer on a medium setting, holding it 6 inches away to minimize heat exposure.What temperature should I Blow Dry my Hair?

If you use the towel-drying or air-drying methods above to get the hair 60-70 percent dry, you can start your blow dry on a low-medium heat setting and still get lasting results. If you have thin, dry, or damaged hair, Lopez recommends staying between 200-300 degrees. For medium textured hair, she says, "don't exceed 350 degrees."

Which heat setting should I use when blow-drying my hair?

Especially when blow drying fine, thin hair, it's better to minimize use of the highest heat setting. or avoid it altogether. Instead, opting for the middle heat setting and the lowest speed will offer you styling flexibility without compromising the condition of your hair.

How do you Dry Your Hair before a blow dryer?

Ideally, your hair should be at least 50% dry before you reach for the blow dryer or hot brush. This helps you achieve the same hairstyle with less heat and drying time. To help speed up this process, use a microfiber towel (or towel turban) to soak up excess water. Focusing on the roots, gently blot or squeeze your hair. Avoid harsh rubbing!.

Can You Blow-Dry Your Hair if it's too hot?

And if you want to blow-dry your hair, remove excess water with a towel first, then use your dryer on a medium setting, holding it 6 inches away to minimize heat exposure. Using a heat protectant on your hair can also lessen breakage, Houshmand says.

Why should you use a blow dryer if your hair is too hot?

Hair, primarily composed of keratin, is sensitive to high temperatures. High heat can dehydrate the hair, leading to frizz. Variable heat options on blow dryers are useful for this reason. Drying at low temperature minimizes heat damage while effectively drying your hair, balancing moisture removal and retention.

Is your hairdryer too hot?
