How long can the breast milk storage incubator be kept



Overview

Up to four days in a standard refrigerator. Up to three to four months inside a standard refrigerator freezer. Up to six to 12 months in a separate deep freezer.

In the refrigerator for up to 4 days. In the freezer for about 6 months is best; up to 12 months is acceptable. Recommended storage times are important to follow for best quality. Want to learn more?

Breast milk can be stored at 0° F or colder for up to 12 months, although using it within 6 months is best. How long can breast milk be stored?

Never store breast milk in disposable bottle liners or plastic bags that are not intended for storing breast milk. Freshly expressed or pumped milk can be stored: At room temperature (77°F or colder) for up to 4 hours. In the refrigerator for up to 4 days. In the freezer for about 6 months is best; up to 12 months is acceptable.

Can breast milk be stored in a freezer?

You can store breast milk in a refrigerator with a freezer that has a separate door (0°F or –18°C) for up to 12 months, although using it within six months is preferable. The earlier you use up your breast milk, the better, because longer storage can diminish the amount of vitamin C in it. The temperature of your freezer should be around 0° F.

How long can you keep frozen breast milk?

However, using the frozen milk within six months is optimal. Keep in mind that research suggests that the longer you store breast milk — whether in the refrigerator or in the freezer — the greater the loss of vitamin C in the milk. It's also important to note that your breast milk changes to meet your baby's needs.

How do you store breast milk in a refrigerator?

Use color-coded or personalized labels, stickers, or bands. Breast milk can also be stored in an insulated cooler with frozen ice packs for up to 24 hours. Keep an appliance thermometer in the refrigerator and check it regularly. The refrigerator should be 40°F or below. Wash hands with soap and water.

How long can breast milk stay in the fridge?

Freshly pumped breast milk can be stored in the back of the refrigerator (39° F or 4° C) for up to four days — just don't forget it's back there. Thawed, previously frozen breast milk can stay in the refrigerator for 24 hours before you have to throw it out. (No mom wants that!) So, only take out what you think your little one will need for a day.

How long does breast milk last at room temperature?

Nwanko et al 1 say six hours for storage of mature milk and 12 hours for colostrum at 27-32°C; Ajusi et al 2 say eight hours at room temperature and Igumbor et al 3 say breast milk may be acceptable for up to eight hours at 15-27°C or four hours at 30-38°C. 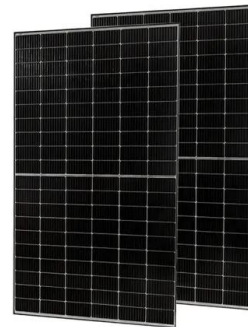

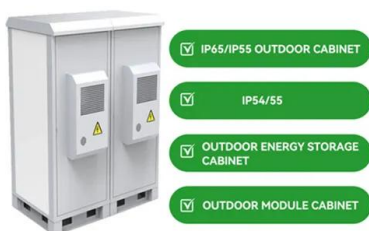

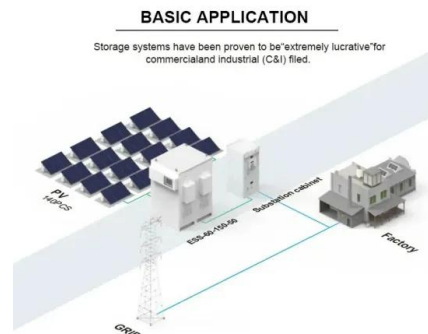
