Unless a part has malfunctioned and is no longer generating electricity, solar panels generally only need to be replaced after 25 years or more.

Solar panels are typically replaced when they become damaged or stop working effectively. Generally, this can be rounded up to every 25 years or so. How often should a solar panel be cleaned?

Solar panels require very little maintenance, especially if they are on a tilt, as rain can wash away any debris. It is generally recommended that you perform solar panel cleaning between two and four times per year. Take extreme care when cleaning. Clean from the ground, as climbing around on your roof can be dangerous.

How often should electrical service panels be replaced?

Electrical service panels should be replaced every 20 to 30 years. If you've been in your home that long, or if you moved into an existing home, your panel may be outdated. If you notice burn marks, hear buzzing or crackling, or smell burning plastic around or inside the electrical panel, have a qualified electrician check the panel immediately.

Can a solar panel be repaired or replaced?

But as long as you have a good warranty, you should be able to have any damaged panels repaired or replaced. Somewhat ironically, the type of weather that most commonly affects panels is heat. When the temperature gets over 77°F (or 25°C), panels lose efficiency approximately 1% per degree.

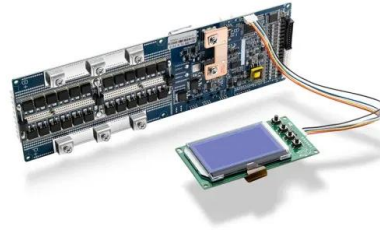
