It's a good idea to schedule maintenance as the seasons change, or every three months, to ensure panels maintain optimal efficiency year-round.

You should perform solar panels maintenance at least twice per year. However, it's important to understand that the need for regular care can fluctuate with local weather conditions.

How Often Should Solar Panels Be Maintained?

Your solar company should advise you on maintenance frequency. Two to four solar panel cleanings per year will likely be all you need.

While there are a number of factors that can affect how often your panels need cleaning, a good rule of thumb is to clean your solar panels once or twice a year. How often should a solar panel be cleaned?

Solar panels require very little maintenance, especially if they are on a tilt, as rain can wash away any debris. It is generally recommended that you perform solar panel cleaning between two and four times per year. Take extreme care when cleaning. Clean from the ground, as climbing around on your roof can be dangerous.

However, solar panels slowly lose efficiency over time, so replacing them after 25-30 years could be recommended to maintain the highest efficiency and performance. Solar panels are made of mostly recyclable parts, meaning they can be taken apart and recycled once they are no longer usable.

How often should a solar installation be inspected?

In truth, there is no regulatory maintenance frequency to adhere to with respect to your solar installation (whether photovoltaic or thermal). It all depends on where it is installed and how rapidly it accumulates dirt. All the same, you should aim for an annual inspection as part of a maintenance contract with your solar installer.

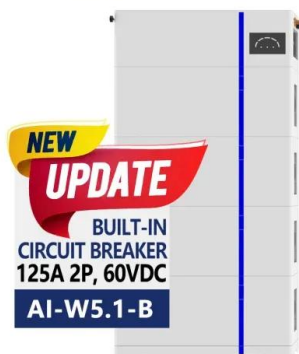
