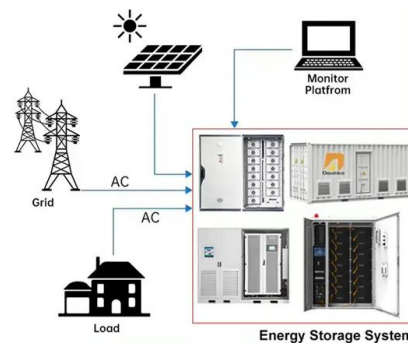


Small Solar Panel Experiment
