Counterfeit panels may feel lighter. Inspect the Frame: The frame should be robust, with clean edges and no visible signs of tampering or poor workmanship. Examine the Junction Box: The junction box should be securely attached with proper seals. □□□□ What are counterfeit solar panels?

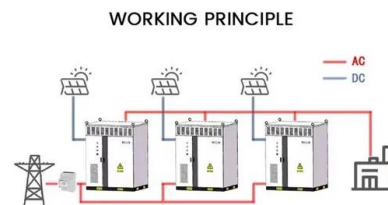
