Do skylights shade solar panels?

Skylights can come in a variety of shapes and sizes, as well as orientations and placement within a roof. The good news is that skylights present very little shade risk, as they are often inset within a roof. But even if they are not completely flush with the roof, skylights typically do not shade solar panels.

How are solar tiles installed?

Installing solar tiles roofs follow a process similar to installing solar panel roofs, but there are distinct differences: Solar panels are mounted directly onto brackets or frames without altering the existing roof material, whereas solar tiles require fitting onto the roof and sealing.

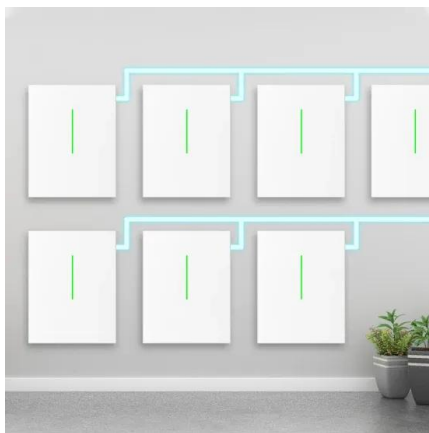
