Overview

What's going on with New Jersey's gas-fired power plants?

NEWARK, N.J. (AP) — Residents of largely minority areas in New Jersey are fighting three proposed gas-fired power plants as they wait for the state's environmental justice law — signed with great fanfare nearly three years ago — to take full effect.

Are drones flying over nuclear power plants in New Jersey?

Drones have been reported above two nuclear power plants in New Jersey and briefly grounded flights at a small airport Friday, according to officials. "PSEG is aware of reports of drones flying over the Salem and Hope Creek Nuclear Generating Stations," said Marijke Shugrue, a spokesperson for the utility company.

Does New Jersey have a nuclear power plant?

In an era of constant message about the need for solar and offshore wind, nuclear power generates 50% of carbon-free electricity in the country - a number that jumps to 90% of the carbon-free power in the state of New Jersey, Kugler said. The New Jersey facility produces the third-highest amount of energy of any nuclear facility in the country.

Will New Jersey halt air traffic over nuclear power plants?

AFP via Getty Images New Jersey's largest utility has asked the feds to halt all air traffic over two of its nuclear power plants — after drones were spotted over the sensitive sites, The Post has learned. Congressman Fred Van Drew (R-NJ) confirmed to The Post that PSE&G filed the request with the Federal Aviation Administration on Friday.

Does New Jersey have a solar power plant?

Small-scale solar, which includes customer-owned PV panels, delivered an additional net 3,413 GWh of energy to the state's electrical grid during 2023.

This was more than twice the generation of New Jersey's utility-scale PV plants. There are two nuclear power stations in New Jersey both operated by PSEG Nuclear.

What are Newark's New gas-fired backup power plants?

Two new gas-fired backup power plants are proposed for the Newark area. Both aim to provide emergency power in the event of severe storms like Superstorm Sandy, which knocked out electricity in 2012, caused nearly a billion gallons of raw sewage to flow into area waterways, and flooded trains and equipment in a rail yard.

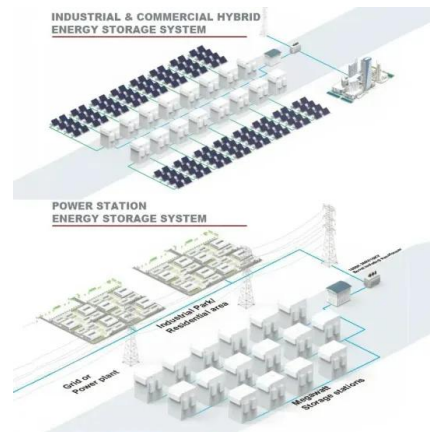

Sewaren 7 Combined-Cycle Power Plant, Woodbridge, New Jersey

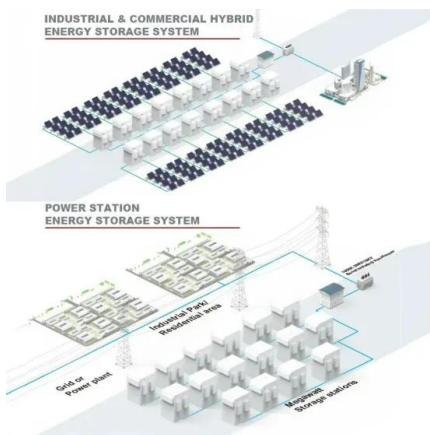

Nine Mile Point says it went into commercial operation on Dec. 14, 1969; Oyster Creek says it

did so on Dec. 23, 1969. But Oyster Creek's license was granted on April 10, 1969, the company said, about four months before one was given to Nine Mile Point, according to a 1970 document from the U.S. Atomic Energy Commission, a precursor agency to the NRC.
