Overview

How did Power Africa support the Liberia Electricity Corporation?

Power Africa supported the Liberia Electricity Corporation as they entered into a public-private partnership arrangement with Jungle Energy Power (JEP), a local energy firm, to operate and manage the Bong County grid.

Will Liberia get a 20 MW power supply in 2020?

In addition, the government signed a Power Purchase Agreement with a solar energy company to provide the country ≥ 20 MW of electricity in 2020 . Despite these efforts, much work remains to be done to improve access to reliable and affordable energy in Liberia.

How can Liberia improve energy security?

One strategy is to diversify the energy mix by increasing the share of domestic renewable energy sources, such as solar and wind power, for electricity generation. By harnessing these indigenous and sustainable energy resources, Liberia can decrease its reliance on imported fuels and enhance its energy security.

What is the installed power capacity of Liberia?

Recently, Liberia's installed electricity capacity reached ~ 200 MW. Most of this capacity comes from HFO and diesel power plants, with limited contributions from hydroelectric and biomass sources . Fig. 2 provides an overview of the installed capacity trend available as an alternative to the grid-based approach and the needs they meet. Fig. 2.

How much solar power does Liberia have?

According to estimates by the World Bank Group, Liberia has a solar potential of ~ 5.4 kWh/m² per day, with up to 6.5 h of sunshine per day on average . Similarly, Liberia has considerable hydroelectric power potential due to its numerous rivers and other resources.

How does Liberia benefit from international support?

Liberia benefits from international support and investments in energy access projects. The United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), the African Development Bank (AfDB), and the World Bank are among the organizations that provide financial and technical support to Liberia's energy sector.

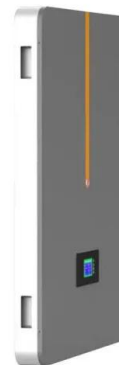

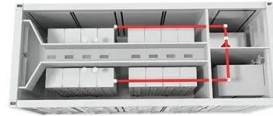
POWER AFRICA IN LIBERIA

Liberia has one of the lowest electricity access rates in the world at less than 2%. In the capital city of Monrovia, only 6.7% of the population has access to electricity. And Monrovia's grid is largely supplied by expensive dieselfueled generation resources. Less than 23 megawatts (MW) of Liberia's on-grid installed generation operate on a daily basis and, therefore, larger facilities
