What is the Solar Power Naija programme?

The Solar Power Naija Programme (SPN) is an initiative launched by the Federal Government of Nigeria (FGN) as part of the Economic Sustainability Plan (ESP) to achieve the roll out of 5 million new solar-based connections in unserved and underserved communities and businesses not connected to the grid.

How does solar power distribution work in Nigeria?

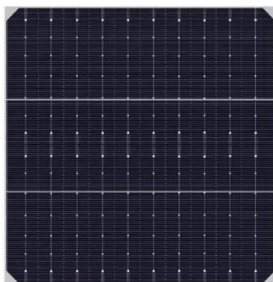


How to Electrify 25 Million Nigerians: Solar Power Nija
