Over the course of July in Faroe Islands, the length of the day is very rapidly decreasing on the start to the end of the month, the length of the day decreases by 2 hours, 10 minutes, implying an average daily decrease of 4 minutes, 21 seconds, and weekly decrease of 30 minutes, 25 seconds.. The shortest day of the month is July 31, with 17 hours, 22 minutes of daylight and ...

The first field solar PV plant in the Faroe Islands has been inaugurated. It is located on an abandoned football field in the village of Sumba, the southern most village on the southern most island of Suðuroy. The 250 kWp plant, which is expected to generate approximately 160 MWh pr. year, is a test site, albeit not a big one.

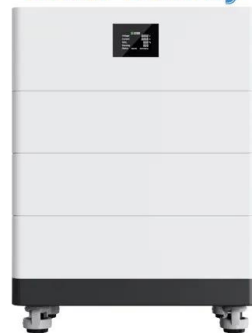

The winter in Faroe Islands experiences essentially constant cloud cover, with the percentage of time that the sky is overcast or mostly cloudy remaining about 71% throughout the season. The highest chance of overcast or

mostly cloudy conditions is 73% on January 28..
The clearest day of the winter is December 1,
with clear, mostly clear, or partly cloudy
conditions 31% of the time.

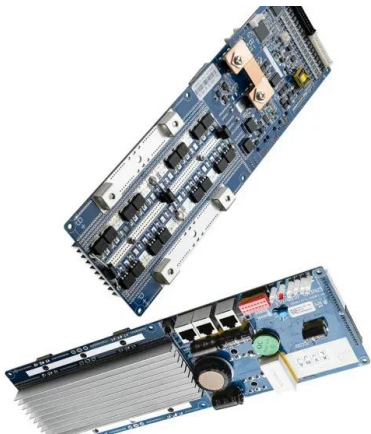
To scale the platform, Fenix developed ReadyPay Solar, a mobile payment-enabled solar system,

The Least-Cost Path to a 100% Renewable

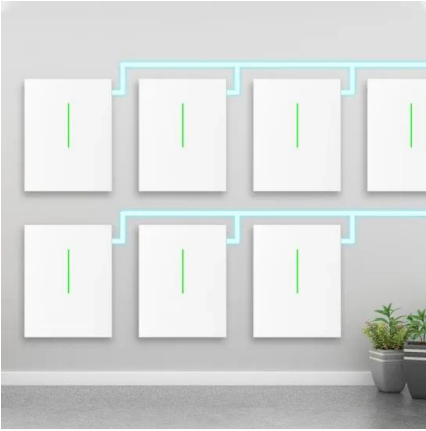

June Weather in Faroe Islands Faroe Islands. Daily high temperatures increase by 3°F, from 49°F to 52°F, rarely falling below 45°F or exceeding 56°F.. Daily low temperatures increase by 4°F, from 43°F to 46°F, rarely falling below 38°F or exceeding 49°F.. For reference, on August 3, the hottest day of the year, temperatures in Faroe Islands typically range from 48°F to 54°F, while

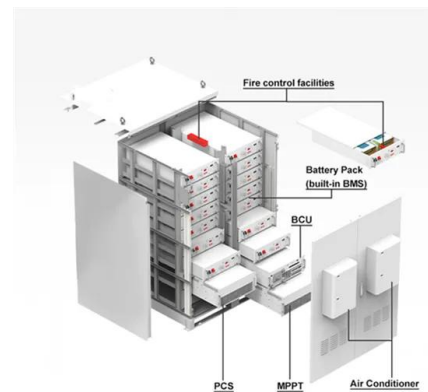


September Weather in Faroe Islands Faroe Islands
