If you've received an offer for "free solar panels," it could be a scam. Always look for businesses you can trust - like Accredited Businesses using the BBB Seal.

Remind prospective customers that while tax credits, rebates, and incentives might be available for solar purchasers who qualify, offers for "free" or "no cost" solar panels are scams.

How the scam works: People posing as solar installers or utility employees call or come to your home and offer free solar panels through made-up government programs or incentives.

And while they promise free or low-cost solar panels, or offer you huge rebates, tax credits, or utility incentives to pay for those solar panels, those are lies. Are solar panels a scam?

Does the Department of energy offer free solar panels?

The Department of Energy and the Solar Energy Technologies Office have got you covered! The Department of Energy is aware of claims of offers for free solar panels or that solar companies must provide solar panels for free if requested.

Do Americans get free solar panels?

American homeowners might be eligible for federal tax credits for solar installations or state subsidies for solar energy, but not free panels. The U.S. government does not provide free solar panels, said a U.S. Department of Energy spokesperson. The department urges people to report scams to the .

Are free solar panels a good idea?

The Facebook post promising free solar panels links to another site with a disclaimer: "'No Cost' means that you may not be required to put any money down at the time of installation if you qualify. Solar is not free, but it usually saves homeowners thousands of dollars more than the initial investment."

Why should you lease solar panels from a reputable solar company?

Leasing solar panels from a reputable solar company gives you access to solar power without paying substantial upfront equipment costs. With this arrangement, you pay the solar leasing company a fixed monthly fee and receive the benefits of having solar power on tap without ownership of the system.

Should you choose a reputable solar energy company?

When temperatures rise, utility costs do, too. While reputable companies can help you save money with clean or solar energy improvements, scammers offer more than they can deliver.
