Solar powered kiosk Cocos Keeling Islands



Overview

How do the Cocos (Keeling) Islands communicate?

The Cocos (Keeling) Islands have access to a range of modern communication services. Digital television stations are broadcast from Western Australia via satellite. A local radio station, 6CKI – Voice of the Cocos (Keeling) Islands, is staffed by community volunteers and provides some local content.

Why are the Cocos Islands called the Keeling Islands?

The territory's dual name (official since the islands' incorporation into Australia in 1955) reflects that the islands have historically been known as either the Cocos Islands or the Keeling Islands. The territory consists of two atolls made up of 27 coral islands, of which only two – West Island and Home Island – are inhabited.

Where can I watch the Cocos (Keeling) Islands?

It is available in paper and electronic formats. The Cocos (Keeling) Islands receives a range of digital channels from Western Australia via satellite and is broadcast from the Airport Building on the West Island on the following VHF frequencies: ABC6, SBS7, WAW8, WOW10 and WDW11.

What is the capital of Cocos (Keeling) Islands?

The capital of the Territory of Cocos (Keeling) Islands is West Island while the largest settlement is the village of Bantam, on Home Island. Governance of the islands is based on the Cocos (Keeling) Islands Act 1955 and depends heavily on the laws of Australia.

What power does Western Australia have over the Cocos Islands?

The Act also gives Western Australian courts judicial power over the islands. The Cocos Islands remain constitutionally distinct from Western Australia, however; the power of the state to legislate for the territory is power-delegated by the federal government.

What is Pulau Kokos (Keeling)?

The territory's Malay name is Pulau Kokos (Keeling). Sign boards on the island also feature Malay translations.

The Cocos (Keeling) Islands only have accommodation for 144 people at any time; therefore, booking accommodation when booking flights is strongly encouraged; The minimum stay is four nights, followed by seven nights due to flight timings. The Cocos (Keeling) Islands consist of two flat, low-lying coral atolls with an area of 14.2 square kilometres (5.5 sq mi), 26 kilometres (16 mi) of coastline, a highest elevation of 5 metres (16 ft) and thickly covered with coconut palms and other vegetation.

The earliest sunset is 5:49 PM on July 1 and the latest sunset is 7 minutes later at 5:56 PM on July 31.. Daylight saving time is not observed in Cocos Islands during 2024.
