# Storage tank system Bermuda



## Overview

---

Does Bermuda have individual water tanks?

In Bermuda, there is no central water supply, so most homes, including early ones from the later 1600s, have their own water tanks. Bermudians and other residents do not pay taxes for water and waste water, unlike in the USA, UK, Europe, etc. See Water and Water tanks, below.

What are Bermuda's water storage regulations?

Bermuda's Public Health (Water Storage) Regulations state that all tanks used for drinking water must be cleared of sludge and properly cleaned not less often than once every six years\*. Those who breach the regulations and are convicted in Magistrates Court can be fined \$168 for a first offence and \$420 for a subsequent offence.

Does Bermuda have a water supply system?

During dry spells, the Water and Sewage Section of Public Works manages and provides water and sewerage services throughout Bermuda. The current government water supply system produces approximately 200 million gallons of water each year. Fortunately, as a last resort, truckloads of fresh water can replenish tanks.

How much does it cost to clean a water tank in Bermuda?

The cost to clean a small to medium-sized water tank in Bermuda is about \$400 to \$650. Water filtration and purification are possible through several local firms. Bermuda's water, mostly found in water tanks, is hard and not the cleanest, containing various particles.

What are the disadvantages of having a water tank in Bermuda?

In Bermuda, having a water tank for each house comes with some advantages but the disadvantages outweigh the advantages. One disadvantage is that rainwater that goes from the sky into a water tank is not purified like treated

water.

Where is the water stored in Bermuda?

In Bermuda, water is stored in tanks located below the houses. The government does not provide a central water supply, so taxes paid by Bermudians and other residents do not include any charge for water and waste water (unlike in the USA, UK, Europe, etc). See Water and Water tanks, below.

### BERMUDA'S WATER SUPPLY

All residences in Bermuda have a roof catchment to collect rain water and an associated storage tank, from which water is supplied to the household via a surface mounted pump and a pressure tank. Under the Public Health (Water Storage) Regulations, 1951 it is stipulated that four fifths of the roof area of every building must be adequately guttered

## Safe Tank Water

Studies have shown that approximately 66% of Bermuda's residential tank waters contain E. coli, an indicator of faecal contamination, at the time of sampling. Additionally 90% of residential tank waters have been found to contain Total Coliforms, which are not



## Bermuda's Architecture and Water Supply

The quality of tank water depends largely on how well the property owner maintains the water system including the roof and tank. The Department of Health of the Bermuda Government recommends, among other things, that the roof should be power-washed or wire-brushed when dirty, or no later than once every two years, to remove old paint and fungal
