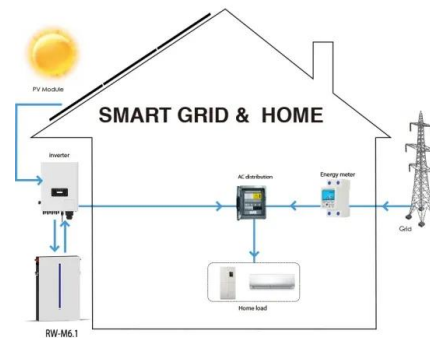

remote that it lies 2,600 km (1,600 miles) from the nearest inhabited land.

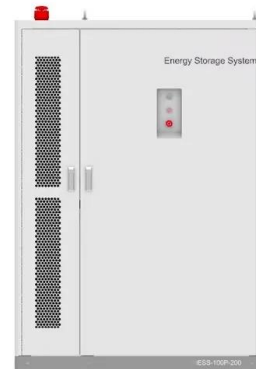
## Bouvet Island

## Evidence from gravity anomalies for interactions of the Marion ...

Bouvet Island lies on 7 Ma crust [3], approximately 300 km to the east of the BTJ and 55 km from the nearest segment of the SWIR. Several recent papers have investigated whether Bouvet Island or Spiess Seamount, located between the BTJ and Bouvet Island, is the position of the Bouvet plume (e.g. [6], [7], [8] ).
