The correct possessive form of the “United States” is the “United States’.” It is the only correct form because we can only use the plural possessive form when referring to an entity made up of multiple different “states” like the USA.

Let’s start by explaining the plural form (the only form) of the United States. Even though it’s a country, the United States refers to all fifty of the states that are united as one country in.

“United States’s” is incorrect. We mentioned that the double “S” ending of the word is too hard for people to pronounce, which is why we leave it out. This is a common rule.

The only correct possessive form is with an apostrophe after “States.” We treat it like a plural possessive noun (even though the United States is treated as a singular country). “United States’” is the correct possessive form we.

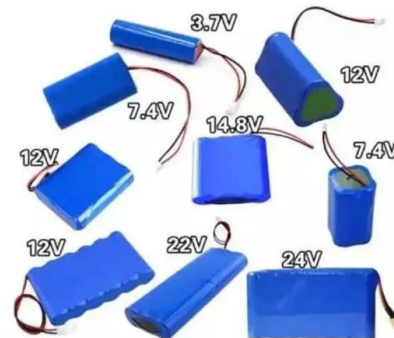
