If your solar system is not delivering sufficient power for which it is rated for, the resulting situation is called a low power situation. This is the most common type of problem and a few, quick, troubleshooting steps will help you find the source of the problem. How do I troubleshoot a solar photovoltaic system?

Troubleshooting a PV solar photovoltaic system will typically focus on four parts of the system: the PV panels, load, inverter, and combiner boxes. The all-around best tool to use for working in most areas of a solar installation is the Fluke 393 FC CAT III 1500 V Solar Clamp Meter .

What happens if a solar panel backsheet fails?

The main cause for solar panel degradation due to back-sheet failure is the delamination of the backsheet or the formation of cracks in the material. When the backsheet fails, the inner components of solar panels are exposed to external agents, and the lifespan of PV modules is reduced.

What should I do if I don't have solar system monitoring?

If you do not have solar system monitoring installed, the first step is to check for any obvious issues with the solar panels, such as a build-up of dirt, dust, mould, or leaves. Maybe a good wash with a soft broom and water is all that they need. Also, check no nearby trees have grown significantly and are shading the panels.
