Solar panels themselves do not cause leaky roofs. However, if the installation is not done correctly or if the roof is not properly maintained, it may lead to leaks.

It's extremely rare that installing solar panels on your roof would cause a leak. Leaks only occur when the small holes drilled for mounting the solar panel brackets aren't sealed properly.

Generally speaking, solar panels will not cause your roof to leak. In fact, a properly installed solar panel system typically has minimal impact on the integrity of your roof.

In virtually all cases, the answer is no. Roof leaks after solar panels are extremely rare. Why does my roof leak after installing solar panels?

There are various reasons your roof could leak after installing solar panels. They mostly have to do with poor installation where mounting holes are not sealed properly, the top is incompatible with solar panels, or the roof is old and not designed for solar panels.

Do solar panels cause roofs to leak?

Solar panels rarely cause roof leaks. When roof leaks occur after solar panel installation, they usually become evident within the first year.
