If not, you're not. Oftentimes they won't even raise your premium. Solar panel theft is extremely rare in the U.S., but it happens. It also usually happens on properties with ground-mounted systems (thieves are lazy). In Europe, where solar is much more prolific, solar panel theft is a more common phenomenon.

What should I do if my solar panels are stolen?

Ensure your homeowner's insurance policy covers your solar panels in case of theft. Some solar panel owners choose to install GPS tracking devices on their panels, allowing them to be tracked and located if stolen. Ensure your solar panels are professionally installed.

Can solar panels damage your roof?

Installing rooftop solar panels can damage your roof unless you work with an experienced and licensed solar installation team. Your home insurance may not cover this damage, forcing you to pay for repairs out of pocket. The only way to know for sure is to speak with your insurance agent.

You can use mechanical locks on the mounting equipment to prevent the panels from being easily removed. The locks should be custom-designed for solar panel installation and tamper-resistant. Installing an alarm system that triggers a loud noise if the panels are tampered with can help deter potential thieves.
