Osaka Castle (大阪城 or 大坂城, Ōsaka-jō) is a Japanese castle in Chūō-ku, Osaka, Japan. The castle is one of Japan's most famous landmarks and played a major role in the unification of Japan during the sixteenth century of the Azuchi–Momoyama period. .

How long did it take to build Osaka Castle?

The Toyotomi Years: 1586-1615 Osaka Castle was originally completed in 1586 as a display of power and grandeur by the samurai warlord and ruler of Japan, Toyotomi Hideyoshi after accomplishing his goal of unifying Japan. The luxurious gold motif is still visible on the castle's exterior today. In 1583, the feudal lord Hideyoshi Toyotomi began construction of Osaka Castle on the former site of the Ishiyama Hongan-ji Temple, which he had destroyed. He intended it to be the center of a unified Japan under his rule.
